



Dear CAFE Faculty and Staff:

Annual performance review time is upon us again. Since I have been Dean, CAFE faculty and staff have been given the opportunity to participate in the review of selected administrators annually and this opportunity is available to you again this year.

Therefore, you are being invited to complete a survey on any or all of the administrators included in the drop-down box located at this link: https://uky.az1.gualtrics.com/jfe/form/SV_4Mx4EApxL5PTHo1

The result of faculty and staff input is reviewed by me and/or the appropriate associate dean or unit head of the administrator being evaluated. The stated purpose of the evaluation is to enhance administrative leadership and effectiveness and to promote a climate of cooperation among faculty, staff, and administration in order to maximize the effectiveness of the unit's execution of its mission.

Key points:

- Although the survey tool allows you to complete a survey on people you don't work with directly, the best use of the survey is when unit heads get as many surveys as possible. So first and foremost, please be sure to evaluate your unit head. If the evaluation process is to meet its objective of enhancing leadership and effectiveness of the unit head, it is important to have full participation of the department's faculty and staff.
- All reasonable efforts are made to safeguard anonymity and confidentiality and we don't know of any cases of these safeguards being breached. Individual respondents should avoid making statements that would identify themselves.
- Please be constructive and offer solutions.
- You will see that you have an opportunity to comment on my performance as well. The survey results about my performance as dean will be shared with the Provost as part of my annual evaluation.

Please take the time to participate in this process. In my opinion, the information received from faculty and staff about administrators will be very constructive. Therefore, I strongly encourage you to thoughtfully complete the survey and provide comments at the end.
