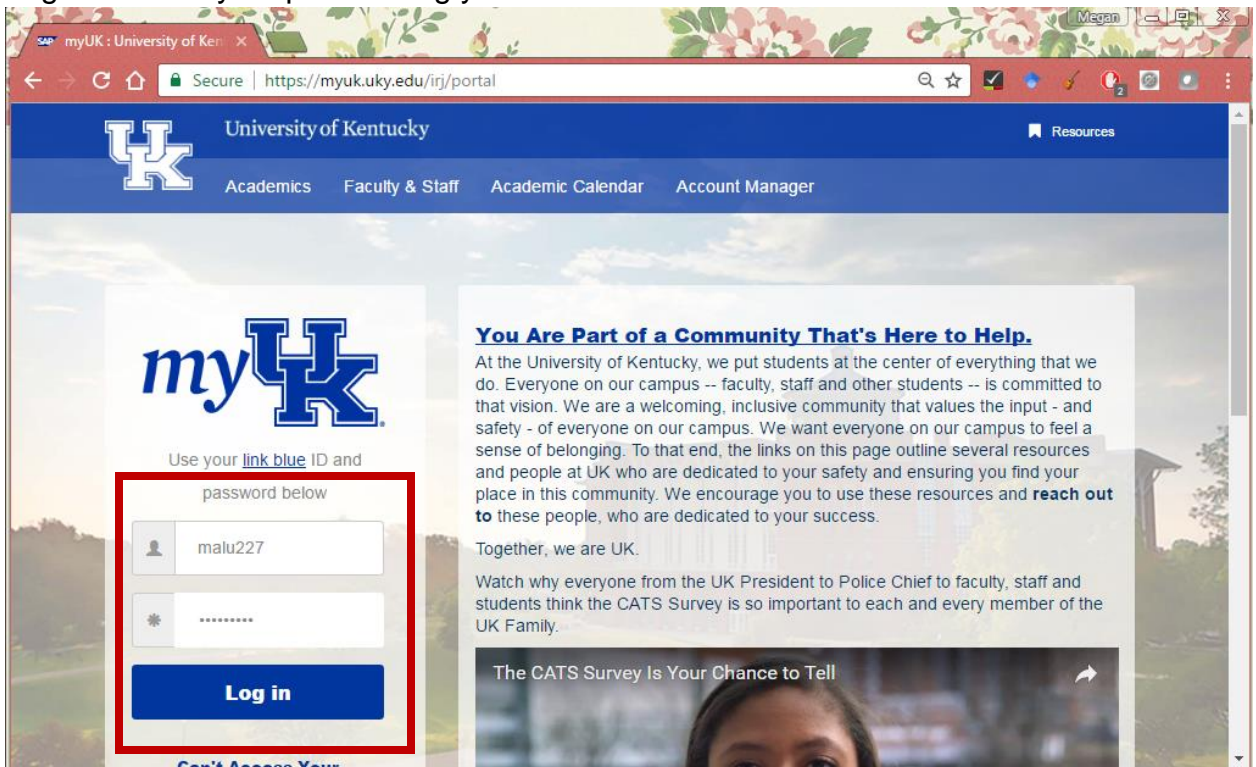


How to Log-in to Digital Measures

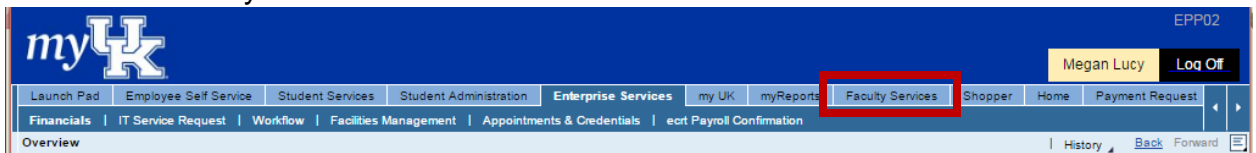
1. To begin with, you need to open an internet browser on your desktop. It is important to note that Microsoft Internet Explorer and Microsoft Edge browsers are not compatible with Digital Measures. You will want to use Google Chrome, Fire fox, or Apple's Safari browser when logging in to Digital Measures.



2. Log in to the MyUK portal using your link blue credentials.

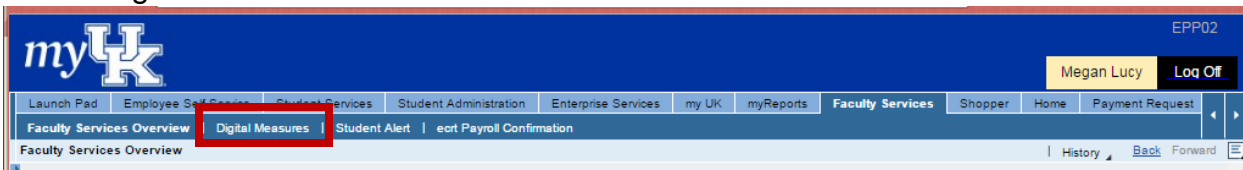


3. Select the Faculty Services tab.

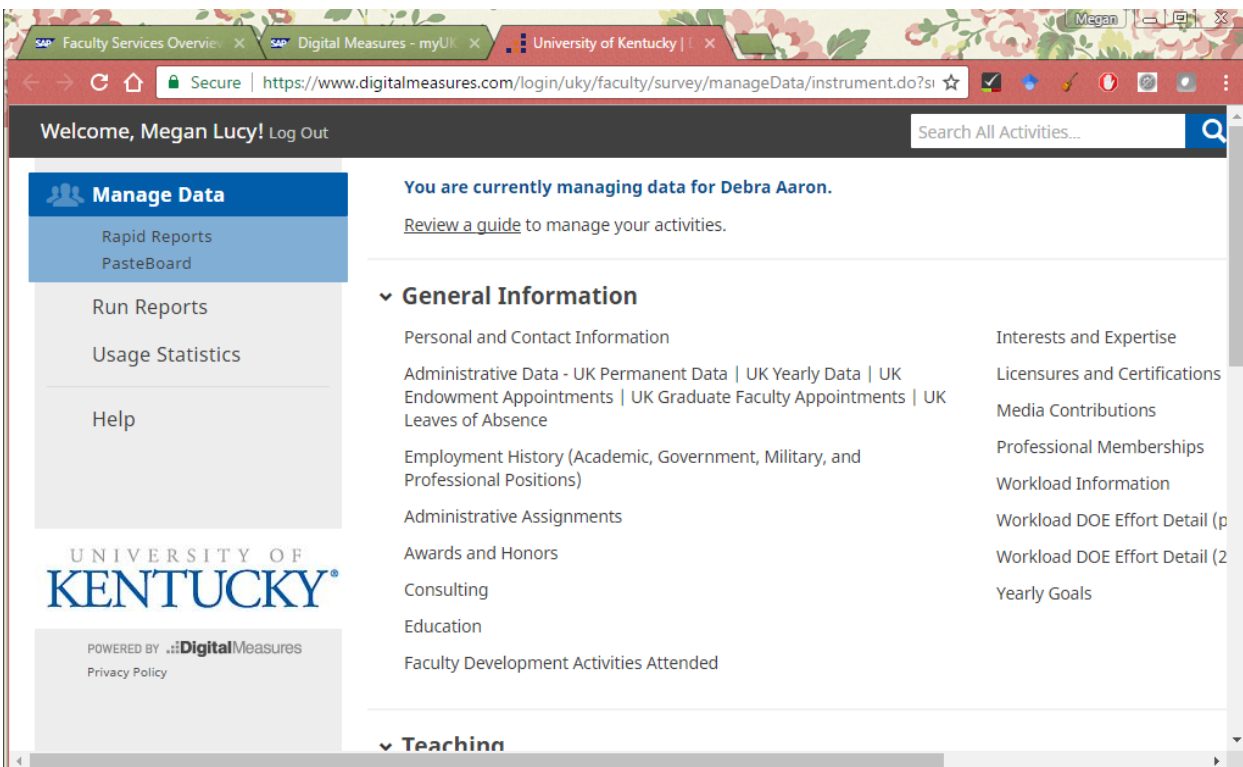


How to Log-in to Digital Measures
